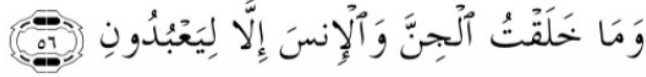


Behaviour Management
House Points Rewards

Our mission at Al-Mahdi Madrasah is to nurture students to become God loving and God Conscious through developing the love for Noble Qur’an and Ahlul Bayt.a.s.

We aspire to have a positive approach and constantly look out for opportunities to acknowledge, praise and reward students. It is important that good behaviour and any achievement by the student is always acknowledged and rewarded.

In addition to verbal praise, awarding of house points is one of the ways to encourage and motivate pupils.

Houses in Madrasah

The students in al Mahdi Madrasah are grouped into houses. There are four houses namely Makkah, Madinah, Karbala and Mashhad. On admission each child is randomly allotted to one of these houses.

Awarding House points:

As a reward for any commendable action undertaken by children, they are rewarded with house points. Some examples of these actions include:

- Responds to questions
- Commendable behaviour / good akhlaq
- Good progress
- Completed homework / tasks
- Wudhu/ Adhan /Iqamah /Salat/ Dua
- Volunteering
- Reads Quran regularly
- For Quran recitation, to encourage children to read Quran regularly, 1 house point is awarded to every child who reads/practices Quran 3 times in a week. If they have read more than 3 times, then 2 housepoints are awarded.
- Any commendable action
- Anything done /presented by a child which the teacher feels deserves a reward

House points can be awarded by all volunteers in any Madrasah section. The number of house points to be awarded for a deed at an instant range from 1 to 5. This is left at the discretion of the Madrasah volunteers.

At the end of each term all the house points are tallied, and the scores are announced. Thereafter, at the end of the Academic year the house with the most house points is presented a trophy. The child collected the most house points is given a special trophy and a gift too. Awards are also given to children in the 1st, 2nd and 3rd position for each house.
